4. Oversubscription Criteria, Year 7

1	Looked after children and previously looked after children, including those children who appear (to the admission authority) to have been in state care outside of England and ceased to be in state care as a result of being adopted.
2	Children who live in the catchment area and who, at the time of admission will have a sibling attending the Academy.
3	Other children who live in the catchment area
4	Children of staff who have been employed at the Academy for at least two years and/or are recruited to fill a vacant post for which there is a demonstrable skill shortage.
5	Children who live outside the catchment area but who are attending an East Leake Academy linked primary school on the closing date for applications and who will have a sibling at the Academy at the time of admission.
6	Children who live outside the catchment area and who, at the time of admission, will have a sibling attending the Academy.
7	Children who live outside the catchment area but who are attending an East Leake Family linked primary school on the closing date for applications.
8	Other children who live outside the catchment area.

5. Sixth Form Oversubscription Criteria (Year 12)

Subject to both the internal and external applicants meeting the minimum entry requirements to gain entry into the Sixth Form – see academy website for details or email enquiries to sixthform@eastleake-ac.org.uk or telephone 01509 852424.
