Published admission number (PAN)

The published admission number for entry to the academy is 30 for Reception. Each subsequent year group (1-6) will admit to a maximum of 15 pupils. It will admit this number of pupils if there are sufficient applications. If fewer than 30 in Reception and 15 in each of the years 1 to 6 applications are received, all applicants will be offered a place.

Oversubscription criteria

1	Looked after children and previously looked after children
2	Children who live in the catchment area on the closing date for applications and who, at the time of admission, will have a sibling attending the academy
3	Other children who live in the catchment area on the closing date for applications
4	Children who live outside the catchment area and who at the time of admission will have a sibling attending the academy
5	Children of staff who have been employed at the academy who are recruited to fill a demonstrable skill shortage.
6	All other children
